Do I Need a Uniform?

Yes. The BSA considers the uniform to be an essential part of the scouting program both for Scouts and Adult Leaders. As an adult leader your uniform identifies you as someone in a position of authority. In Cub Scouts, the scouts refer to their leaders as "Akela".

Do I Need to Get Everything?

No. The minimum uniform required for an Adult leader in Pack 348 is:

- The Tan Leader Shirt. The following items are added to the Shirt:
 - Blue Leader Epaulets
 - o Crossroads of America Council Patch
 - Leader Rank Patch
 - o Pack 300 Numbers
 - o Den Number Patch
- Optional, but Recommended items include:
 - Neckerchief
 - o Neckerchief Slide
 - o Hat
